## Native Sod 2021 Price List





Each piece of sod is approximately 24” x 24” (4 square feet), unless sold in clumps. For sod sold in clumps, each clump contains one mature plant and is approximately 12” x 12” (1 square foot).

Minimum orders apply. Delivery charge varies by location.

Add some color and texture to your lawn and landscape with the use of native sod. Use berries, ferns and moss as border plants, rock wall and stairwell accents, or highlight the sod itself by making it the main attraction.

Lawns aren't just for grass anymore!






<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Blueberry Sod</b>  <i>Vaccinium angustifolium</i>            100 sq. ft. per pallet            Min order of 1 pallet—\$700            \$7.00 per sq foot</p>		<p>Maine’s famous low-bush wild blueberries! An antioxidant super fruit with four season beauty. In addition to tasty berries, you get perky pink to white bell shaped flowers in May, blazing scarlet fall color and red twigs all winter. Full sun, and acidic, well-drained soil is preferred. Will need maintenance. Zones 3-7.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Bunchberry</b>  <i>Cornus canadensis</i>            150 sq. ft. per pallet            Min order of 1 pallet—\$1,275            \$8.50 per sq foot</p>		<p>Nothing is more exquisite than this lovely ground cover. It grows to 3 inches tall and slowly spreads. Two inch whorled leaves, dark-green and shiny in summer, become wine-red in the fall. Charming 4-point white flowers from late spring to summer, scarlet berries in the fall. Partial sun/moderate shade, moist soil preferred. Zones 2-6.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Huckleberry</b>  <i>Gaylussacia baccata</i>            150 sq. ft. per pallet            Min order of 1 pallet—\$1,500            \$10.00 per sq foot</p>		<p>A deciduous shrub often in dry areas. Grows to about 1-3 feet in height. Huckleberry is a great ground cover for thin, rocky woods. The berries are black with white to pink flowers blossom in the spring with an excellent fall display from orange to crimson. Plant in partial shade to full sun; wet, moist or dry soils will work. Zones 5-9.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Hay-Scented Ferns</b>  <i>Dennstaedtia</i>            200 sq. ft. per pallet            Min order of 1 pallet—\$1,400            \$7.00 per sq foot</p>		<p>A perfect plant to prevent erosion, it’s a very tough, fast spreading, lacy fern. It adapts to drier soil as well as damp soil. Fine textured, it has a fresh spring green color. It is a medium grower to about 15” and is from the Bracken Fern family. The crushed fronds do actually have the scent of fresh hay! The golden fall color is a bonus. Zones 3-8.</p>

<p><b>Cinnamon Ferns</b>  <i>Osmunda cinnamomea</i>          50 clumps per pallet          Min order of 2 pallets—\$1200          \$12.00 per clump</p>		<p>Always an eye catcher and easily recognized. This big bold fern can grow up to 3' tall. The unfurling fronds and stems have an appealing, rich wooly coating as they emerge from the ground in the spring. They grow in moist woodland, bogs, peatlands, thickets, swamps, ditches and stream banks. Prefers moderate shade. Zones 1-11. *sold in clumps</p>
<p><b>Ostrich Ferns</b>  <i>Matteuccia struthiopteris</i>          50 clumps per pallet          Min order of 2 pallets—\$1200          \$12.00 per clump</p>		<p>An elegant, symmetrical fern with ostrich feather-like fronds, this vase-shaped fern has broad fronds near the tips and tapers back down to the crown. Plant in filtered sun to full shade. Since this fern likes moist, shaded areas, it's great near wet areas of your landscape. Zones 3-7. *sold in clumps</p>
<p><b>Haircap Moss</b>  <i>Polytrichum commune</i>          150 sq. ft. per pallet          Min order of 1 pallet—\$1,275          \$8.50 per sq foot</p>		<p>The needle-like appearance of this moss doesn't reflect the softness of it when you run your hand across it! With no true root system it requires nothing more than a firm soil bed in a location with adequate shade, acidic soil and moisture to flourish. Growth of about 1/2" to 3" can be expected. Zones 2-15.</p>
